Discovering the Way

1. Jesus Was Not Afraid to Stand for Truth (Matthew 10:34; Luke 12:40 – 53) The courage of Jesus is seen in His unflinching declaration of truth, regardless of popularity, safety, or diplomacy.


2. The Enemies of Jesus Cared More about Pleasing Others Than Living by the Truth (Matthew 15:1–9, 12; Luke 19:45–48)

Jesus's stance for the truth placed Him squarely in opposition to His enemies, who sought every opportunity to kill Him.


Starting Your Journey

Four lessons remain from this study. First, remembering your mission helps you navigate through any storm. Stay focused. Second, encountering evil requires sword-like confrontation, not peace-keeping compromise. Stay alert. Third, being bold when there's a principle worth fighting for is worth the risk, even if it offends and results in misunderstanding. Stay strong. Fourth, speaking up for what is right is no guarantee you'll win or gain respect. Stay realistic.
