The Heart of the Matter

2. Jesus Became a Flesh-and-Blood Man (John 1:14; Philippians 2:5–8)

Jesus has always existed, but He set His divine glory aside to become like us.

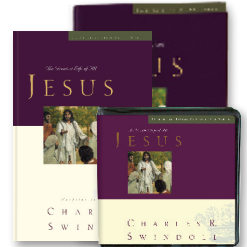


Starting Your Journey

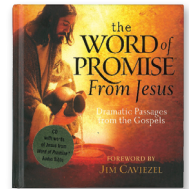

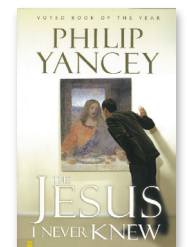
