The Heart of the Matter

The fear of the Lord stands as one of the significant emphases of the book of Proverbs. It involves following God with reverence and taking His direction seriously. Yet this has become an increasingly rare and invaluable quality in a culture, both inside and outside the church, that promotes striking out on our own and making our own personal needs and desires primary. To counter this, Proverbs offers today's woman guidance on becoming a woman who fears the Lord.



Discovering the Way

1. Traits of a Godly Woman (Proverbs 31)

Godly women are rare and invaluable, and those who are also married present four distinct qualities to their husbands.

2. A Woman Who Fears the Lord (Proverbs 9:10)

Godly women live by the guidance and direction God provides. Five qualities distinguish women who live according to the fear of the Lord.




Starting Your Journey

Based on the life of Mary, the mother of Jesus, we find six qualities that describe terrific mothers.




Starting Your Journey

EPHESIANS 5:21–24



The Heart of the Matter

Some sections of Scripture seem more like a minefield littered with explosives than a treasure chest full of truth. One such section of Scripture deals with the topic of a wife submitting to her husband. We step into it with the full understanding that the topic is known for flaring tempers and causing misunderstandings. Rather than ignoring it, how much more does this passage cry out for a level-headed approach informed by historical, cultural, and biblical contexts? So let's tackle the question: What does submission really mean?



Discovering the Way

1. Setting the Context (Ephesians 5:18–21)

This controversial text comes in a particular context, one that emphasizes the filling of the Spirit and the presence of submission in every relationship. However, this text has been regularly misunderstood and misapplied.

2. Submission in the Roles of Life (Ephesians 5:22–24)

The life of submission is founded upon the inherent dignity and equality of all people, being modeled after the life of Christ Himself.




Starting Your Journey

The Heart of the Matter

Esther, a beautiful, young Jewish woman, eventually became the queen of Persia—a decision that would later preserve the destiny of the Jewish race. Woven through the book that bears her name are many of the qualities that caused Esther to stand out and find "favor in the eyes of all who saw her" (Esther 2:15). Such a rare blend of beauty and dignity! These qualities still hold our interest today, for now, as then, they cause a watching world to stand up and take notice. All women can be encouraged to follow Esther's example . . . for these qualities are not unique to that one lovely woman.

1. God-Given Strengths Found in Women

God has instilled a variety of strengths in women, including a unique vulnerability in relationships and a special responsiveness to the things of God.

2. Esther: The King's Favorite . . . and Why (Esther 2:8–20)

As one among many beautiful and accomplished women, Esther won over the king of Persia. Six qualities served as the foundation of her character.
