STYLE	Short statements that declare profound truths and provide wisdom for life		
THEME	“Fear of the LORD is the foundation of wisdom.” (<i>Prov. 9:10</i>)		
KEY VERSE	Proverbs 9:10		
CHRIST IN PROVERBS	Wisdom is incarnate in Christ, who is “the wisdom of God” (<i>1 Cor. 1:24</i>). He is “wisdom itself” (<i>1 Cor. 1:30</i>), and “in him lie hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge” (<i>Col. 2:3</i>).
