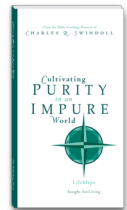
How successful are you in facing these temptations? If you want an honest answer, ask your wife. She'll jump at the chance to help you become a better man, husband, and father.



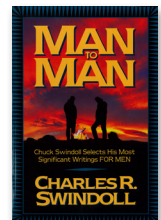
